The latest results from Australia, with regard to the England team are as follows;

Visually Impaired Competition is still in the group play rounds and we should receive the results as to who has gone through to the playoff rounds tomorrow.

B6 / 8 - Physical Disability Open Team Event

Singles - no England player through to the final playoffs, but David Fisher, Robert Dixon-Smith and Lea Davis in the Consolation Singles event which all points gained go toward the team trophy.

Pairs - Irene Cheer and Roger Wilton through to group one playoffs and Mike Diston and David Fisher through to the group two play offs.

Triples - Malcolm Otton, George Pierrepoint and Lea Davis are through to the playoffs.

Fours - Bob Love, Laurie Turner, Les Smith and Val Bradley are through to the play off rounds.

There were 18 teams entered this event. They were split into 4 groups for round robin preliminary round play. The

top two teams in each group then qualify for the two play-off groups who then play three matches after which the top teams compete for the gold, silver and bronze.

Players not making the qualifying rounds go into the Consolation Events, all points gained go toward the countries total for the Team Trophy. Countries with more than one team entered have their points divided by the number of their teams.
