Competition Rules

The Cerebral Palsy Sport's National Athletics Championships will be run under International Paralympic Committee Athletics Rules and Regulations 2016-2017.

For resulting, please be aware for field events only, we will be using the IPC Athletics Raza points table to provide the final positions in each event. Medals will be awarded in two age groups, Under 16's and over 16's.

On the track, medals will be awarded in Bronze, Silver and Gold in each class and for under 16's and over 16's age groups. If only one athlete is in a class/ age group a gold medal will still be presented. **Please note if you do not have a National or International Classification no medals will be awarded.**

Personal implements may be used in the competition, officials will be located in the equipment store to check and weigh individual items, please ensure you do this in advance of your competition time.

Throwing events: all athletes will be allowed six throws. For seated throwers they will complete three throws then a short break if required then a further three throws.

Athletes in seated throws will report directly to the event location with their throwing frames, officials will be checking frames prior to the competition starting and athletes are reminded to ensure their competition number is displayed on the throwing frame to be used.

All ambulant field athletes are required to report to event location 15 minutes prior to the scheduled event time. Where an athlete may have a clash of events i.e. field/track then please inform the official if you need to leave the event location.

Wheelchair/RaceRunner track racers must check-in with the track marshal 15 minutes prior to the scheduled event time. Athletes are required to have their competition numbers displayed on the back and front left side of their wheelchair/RaceRunner

Ambulant track athletes must check-in with the track marshal 15 minutes prior to the scheduled event. Athletes are required to have their competition numbers displayed on the back and front.

Photo Consent: If you are wanting to take photos please make sure you sign a consent form at the registration desk where you will be given a wristband and this must be clearly

on display when you are taking pictures. Please be aware that there are athletes that have NOT given consent so be mindful when you are taking photos.

Refreshments are available from the tuck shop at the club house and there are also vending facilities at the sports centre.
