Purpose:

Cerebral Palsy Sport believes that sound and effective policies in the following areas will significantly benefit the overall efficiency of the organisation, and promote the safe operations of all events and activities and provide a safe environment to conduct the charities' activities.

Policy Statement Section 2: Policy Statement

1. It is the Policy of Cerebral Palsy Sport, that great importance is attached to safeguarding the health, safety and welfare of those employed by it, by fulfilling both its legal and moral responsibilities.
2. The Board of Trustees and Chief Executive consider that the proper discharge of the Health and Safety Policy is an integral part of management and it is therefore the duty of all managers to do everything possible to prevent injury to individuals. In addition, Cerebral Palsy Sport request all employees to follow health and safety instructions, to be aware of their duty of care to themselves and their colleagues and not to interfere with anything provided for their health, safety or welfare. It is important that employees, as part of their duty, report any condition that appears to be dangerous or unsatisfactory. Legal requirements provide for the minimum standards of health and safety; the aim of Cerebral Palsy Sport is to achieve a standard that is above the minimum where practicable.
3. This will be achieved, so far as is reasonably practicable by:
 - ❖ The provision and maintenance of safe equipment and safe systems of work.
 - ❖ Ensuring the safe use, handling, storage and transport of materials, substances and other articles.
 - ❖ The provision of necessary information, instruction, training and supervision to ensure all employees are aware of their responsibilities for safety.
 - ❖ Risk Assessments to be undertaken by National Officers to ensure and maintain a safe place of work and healthy environment.
 - ❖ Provide a system for rapidly identifying and remedying hazards and where hazardous conditions cannot be eliminated, by providing suitable protective clothing and equipment.

- ❖ Regular Health and Safety Committee items on CP Sport team meeting agendas.
