The Paralympic Pathway for Athletics currently includes athletes from the following impairment groups. All events and eligibility are subject to appropriate classification and future amendments by the IPC:

- Blind & partially sighted – most track and field events
- Athletes with cerebral palsy (and brain trauma) – most track and field events
- Amputees and les autres – most track and field events
- Manual wheelchair users – seated throws & wheelchair racing
- Dwarf athletes – shot / discus / javelin (men); shot / discus (women)
- Powered wheelchair users – club throw and discus
- Athletes with a learning disability – 1500m, long jump and shot
